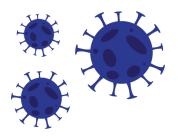


Survey of 475 KOLs across 21 specialties* based in USA

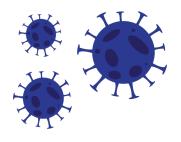




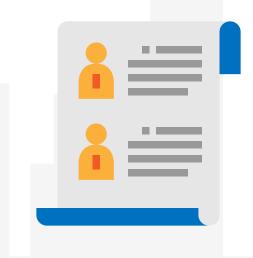




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SURVEY METHODOLOGY



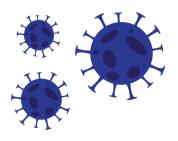
A KOL research firm was hired to conduct a survey with KOLs in the USA. An online survey was created and open from April 30 - June 5, 2020 and sent to KOLs across the USA. Only completed surveys were included in the data analysis. Respondents were only allowed to participate one time and duplicate surveys from a single email address were not accepted. The survey results were not weighted.

Only Key Opinion Leaders (KOLs) that responded that they regularly interact with Medical Science Liaisons (MSLs) were included in the data presented in this report. KOLs self-identified their specialty of medicine.

As a result, a total of 475 KOLs representing 21 specialties, all based in the USA, completed the survey and are included.



Survey of 475 KOLs across 21 specialties* based in USA



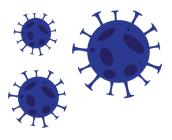


Are you a professional that regularly interacts with Medical Science Liaisons (MSLs) from industry partners like pharmaceutical companies?

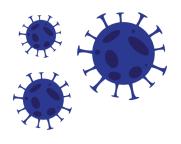

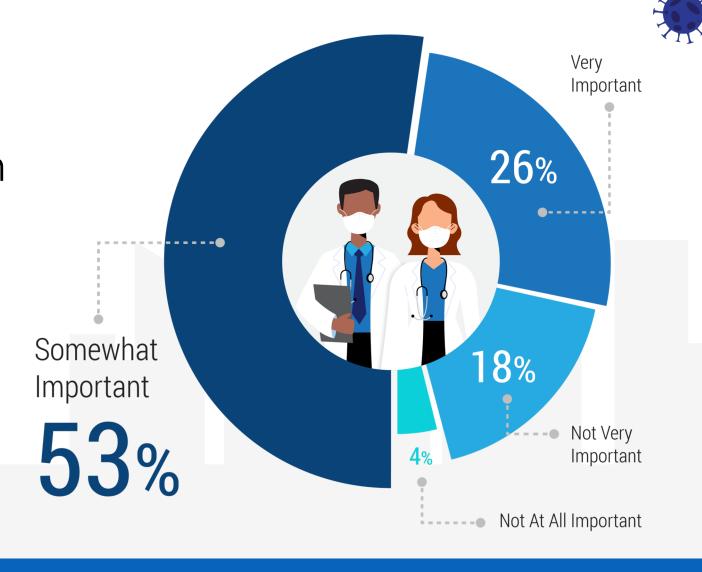

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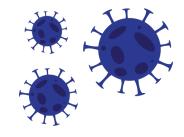
How important is it for KOLs to maintain contact with **Medical Science** Liaisons during the COVID-19 pandemic?

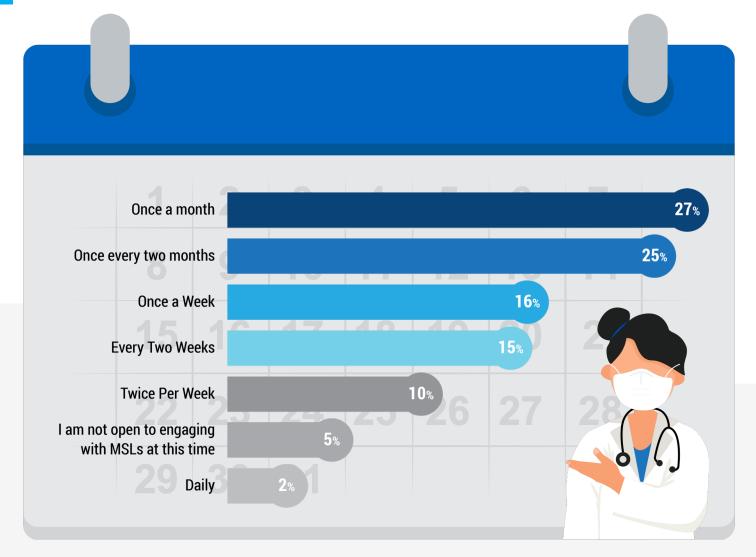






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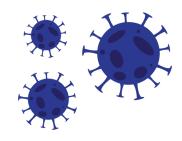




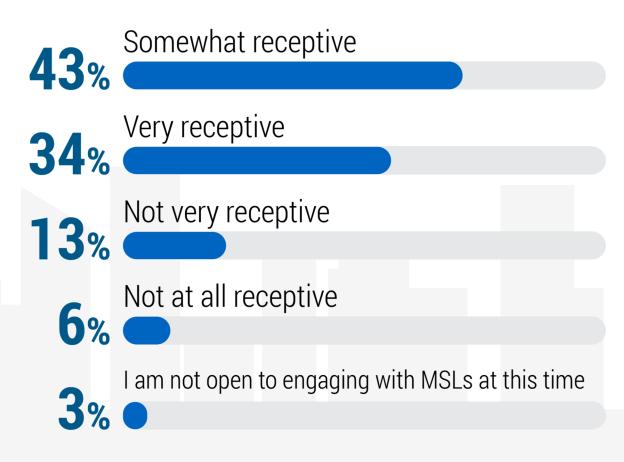
In general, as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic, how frequently do KOLs prefer to communicate with a **Medical Science** Liaison?



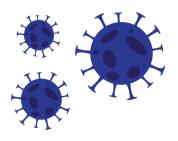
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How receptive are KOLs to engaging virtually (Zoom, Skype, Webex, etc.) with MSLs?



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Beyond the COVID-19 pandemic, should MSLs continue to utilize virtual **technology** to engage with you?

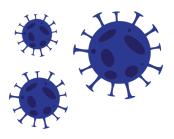

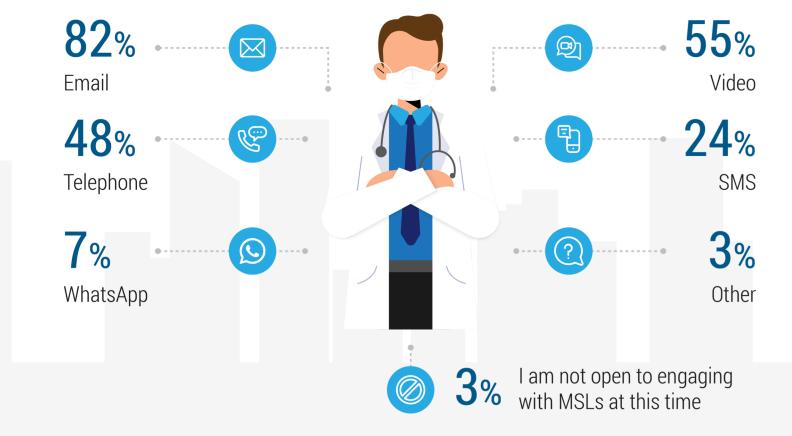

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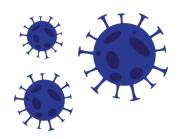
